Meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM by Supervisor Charles Maziasz. Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all. Minutes of February 11, 2008 were read by the Clerk, Barb Hall at 7:06 PM. Financial report for the month was given by Treasurer Charles Veneros. Motion by Allen Barr, supported by Marvin Shebel, to approve the minutes and financial report. MOTION CARRIED at 7:08 PM. Information Reports (7:09 PM)

Commissioner Leonard Page – Excused out of State
Dawn Barr – Library has received \$80,000 from estate of Spies. Mentioned treasurer needed for a short time.

Correspondence (7:10 PM)

Received and filed for the month. Discussion on increase in natural gas. Trustee Allen Barr to schedule a PIE&G representative to talk to Board.

Old Business (7:15PM)

Recycling-Brief explanation given by Supervisor. Should have enough signatures to put on ballot for August. Will know by next month meeting. Surveys show two to one in favor of recycling.

Insurance Claim – Picture that was damaged and frame - Lois Ballard to check into for us. New bids as want to keep siding all same. Should have for next month meetings.

Board of Review-Brief update by Supervisor. Twenty one showed up. Main question “Why did taxes go up in this day and time.” Lake property 75 feet or less up 20%. Concern also on Devereaux Lake water level.

Supervisor wants the poverty exemption maximum total value of assets for eligibility to be not to exceed \$125,000 in True Cash Value instead of \$75,000. **Motion** by Allen Barr, supported by Marvin Shebel, to change True Cash Value not to exceed \$125,000 in Poverty Exemption Guidelines. **MOTION CARRIED** Four Yeses Opposed Charles Veneros Clerk to redo resolution to state this and get copy to Assessor.
