Commissioner Leonard Page – Informed Board that County Administrator Mike Overton has not received a response from the DNR on the three parks closed in the County. Trying for a long term solution. August 28<sup>th</sup> Public Hearing on the increase from 3 to 5 Road Commissioners will be held at the High School Auditorium. He stated that he has heard a rumor that the County Commissioners cannot redistrict for the Road Commissioners. Reported eight new buses for Straits Regional Ride will be coming and is funded by Federal and State grants. Council on Aging pole barn that was dismantled in Mackinaw and stored at the Airport will be reassembled by a grant and donated to SRR. County Commissioners have approved the purchase of a van for the Sheriff Department to the tune of \$27,000. To be used for transport of bodies/prisoners. Discussion followed on recycling.
