Received and filed for the month. Brief discussion around prescription drug cards and different plans in the County. More to come as County Administrator is looking into this item.

**Old Business (7:11 PM)**

Recycling – County Administrator Mike Overton gave a brief update. 24/7 locations will be behind the County Building in Cheboygan and behind the Napa building in Indian River for the winter, not sure on summer maybe behind Ken's. Will purchase six bins and the fee for people who want to recycle from an opt out township will be \$36.00. People will receive a card permit for their dashboard right hand side. Discussion followed concerning Aloha Township- only option now would be to opt in and pay the \$24 per household from general fund. Or wait until June pay ½ or \$12.00 per household. Questions raised if County would put bins at hall without opting in?? Tom Slunick asked County if there was a 5 or 10 year plan?? A Curb side plan?? Consensus of the Board to wait for survey results in a few months. If continue in Spring area would need to be graded and prepped before any bins could be put in.

**New Business (7:40 PM)**

Commissioner Page shared information with the Board at this point. Discussed old County garage and roof replacement in Cheboygan. Also building has cracking on side. Looking at three options: 1) buy H & H building, 2) New Garage on Dotski Road or 3) replace roof etc. This garage houses the Cheboygan Trucks and other equipment. Also shared County Maintenance Dept building pole barn and the moves. Shared a little on

the Black Lake School situation. Per Commissioner Page County budget process look good.

**Appointment of Election Inspectors-** For the Jan 15<sup>th</sup> election they will be Barb Hall, Chairperson with Joyce Barr and Ann Smith as inspectors. Totally reimbursed by the State.

**Web Site Update-**Absentee applications are on the website with more to come.

**Humane Society Contract. – Motion** by Allen Barr and supported by Charles Veneros to make contract for \$700 the same as last year with the Humane Society. MOTION CARRIED
